For 5 years in a row, the Lerner and Rowe Gives Back Charity Golf Classic has been a way to mix a fun day of golf with a means to give back to the community.

With the passing of each year the annual charitable event grows so that the following year is even bigger and better than the year before.

These efforts are reflected in the total amounts raised year after year to benefit local charities.

2016's golf classic fundraiser generated over \$200,000, 2017's generated over \$250,000, and this year's event generated \$283,000!

# PHOENIX CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL 7<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL ABCI5 TELETHON







Lerner and Rowe Gives Back Foundation was a \$10,000 level partner for the 7th Annual ABC15 Telethon to benefit Phoenix Children's Hospital (PCH). The Foundation was also the only non-profit established by a law firm to give back by actively volunteering for the phone bank to assist in accepting calls from other caring donors.

PCH is the sixth-largest children's hospital in the country, as well as the largest source of pediatric care to low-income families in Arizona.

All donations received as a result of the Telethon directly went to the Hospital's Hope Fund "which finances innovative research, cutting-edge technology, the recruitment of leading physicians, and the child-friendly programs and services that make the hospital environment more comfortable for young patients."

### #LOVEPUP IT'S HIP TO CHIP PROGRAM






Lerner and Rowe Gives Back became the exclusive annual partner of #LovePup's It's Hip to Chip Program. This is #LovePup's biggest program yet!

The It's Hip to Chip Program aims to ensure that all dogs adopted from either of the Maricopa County Animal Care and Control Animal Shelters locations receive a microchip upon their adoption. Microchips make it easier for owners to find their lost pets.

By storing the owner's contact information in a database, a microchip takes the guesswork out of trying to find a runaway pup. And, since the microchip is implanted under the dog's skin, there's no need to worry about losing the device like a collar or tag.

It was also with great pleasure that we learned soon after the program launched a pup was reunited with it's owners after a brief separation.







### BACK TO SCHOOL BACKPACK GIVEAWAY











Lerner and Rowe's Back to School Giveaways in Phoenix and Tucson were a huge success! The turnouts in each market for 2018 were bigger than ever!

The goal for both events was to set up future generations for success by helping local school-age kids in need. Reason being that when you give a child the basic tools they need to learn, you help remove a major learning obstacle. That child can now focus more on classwork and less on not having a pencil or paper to complete assignments.

Students were given spiral notebooks, loose paper, colored pencils, rulers, scissors, glue sticks, crayons, pencil pouches, and more to fill their packs.

### SOLDIER'S BEST FRIEND KSLX - 4 PETS FOR VETS

The original amount Lerner and Rowe Gives Back planned to donate was \$4,500. It was then raised to \$5,000. Kevin Rowe then upped the ante of the amount contributed by agreeing to give Soldier's Best Friends a total of \$8,500 to help bump the total funds raised for Veterans to just under \$60k!

All funds raised during KSLX radio personalities Mark and Neanderpaul's week long 4 Pets for Vets promotion went to the Soldier's Best Friend charity; specifically to cover the costs of pairing four specialty-trained dogs to four veterans at no cost to the veterans.



Most of the service or therapeutic companion dogs come from local animal shelters and are then trained and paired with a veteran. The aim of the training is to help local Veterans living with combat-related post traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) or traumatic brain injuries (TBI) with readjustment challenges and symptoms that are often triggered by a return to civilian life.

It was amazing to be part of the group of volunteers that helped construct this new playground from the ground up to replace the one ARCH lost to a fire this past summer.








