

THANKSGIVING GIVEAWAYS

In addition to giving away 1,700 turkeys and 500 hams with \$20 gift cards for side fixings in five cities, we also held a Thanksgiving themed Facebook live contest so that those who could not attend an event still had the chance to participate. The first 125 people to submit answers to the eight questions asked during the live event were gifted a \$50 gift card!

We couldn't be happier for those who won and are filled with gratitude to have the opportunity to help kick off the holidays with some extra light and love.

In partnership with Clark County School District Police, Behind the Blue Nevada, and the Just One Project, our Las Vegas outreach team enjoyed serving our East Las Vegas neighbors during a contactless drive-through giveaway at Ruby Thomas Elementary School. We are grateful for the contributions from our partners and for the manpower provided by our volunteers and team that helped make it possible for us to give away 600 frozen turkeys, boxes of fixings (enough to feed a family of five), and other food items to families in need.

We are also grateful to our community partners who serve as force multipliers producing greater results than we could ever accomplish independently.



















CHICAGO POLICE DEPARTMENT'S CAPS PROGRAM

In looking forward to the future, Lerner and Rowe created the 2021 College Scholarship Program, which is designed to provide financial assistance to low-income students pursuing higher education.








VIRTUAL #FRIENDDAY EVENT








LOOKING OUT FOR ANIMAL WELFARE




